

COPPTA Member Meeting - 1/11/2023

Start at 6:06 PM – Call to Order

- December 2022 meeting minutes will be posted after meeting and will be approved at February Meeting

Executive Update:

- Review of last meeting's WLWV Security and Facilities presentation – presented information, seeking input from CPPS community; COPPTA will be sending out a link from WLWV for feedback. They welcome input and feedback from community
- Thank you to from S McGregor – we've had great events, great turnout for meeting and input – making a difference – big thank you to all.
- Upcoming events for 2023:
 - o **MOVIE NIGHT** - January 20th – Erin Keller / Movie Night – she's working with Meg Leonard to finalize planning and movie selection (kids vote proposed – Lorax amongst one suggested). Timing is likely 6 PM start – NOT a drop off event (family event and attendance); PJs and blankets encouraged. Concessions TBD (suggested BYO guidelines – water only, no peanuts and nothing sticky). More information / details to come out this coming Friday.

Principal Report from Meg Leonard

- SAVE THE DATE: May 4 – Talent Night – Cedaroak's Got Talent 2023 – prerecorded snippets and red carpet. In person event and a movie presentation
- Ms. Perkins – as part of the auction fundraising, wanted to share that the library needs help.
 - o History section example
 - computer book example – dated (steve jobs and Wozniak are on the cover, no girls or diversity depicted).
 - Min cost now is \$20/ book
 - Time to reinvigorate library so kids see themselves in the book
 - o Want to address classroom libraries too, to reflect the best that is out there
 - o Looking for STEM/STEAM activities – ozobots, need enough for classroom
 - o Show your library some love – February event. Lots of graphic novels, middle grade chapter books, high interest books kids will select on own
- This will benefit ALL classes and kids
- (Ms. Willey) Upper grades desperately need struggling readers (might be up to 2 levels behind) – Haley, Dylan and she are looking at High Noon book series – look like chapter books but target skill levels. Hoping for 3 to 4 sets per classroom (about \$85/set of 10 or 12).
- **(NOTE FOR PTA FOLLOW UP ACTION:** PTA will be sending PTA Grant paperwork to all teachers)
- We approved last month a budget item (\$5000) last month for items like this – especially immediate needs. We used \$2000 for headsets, another \$2000 on another ask leaving about \$1000 left – Treasurer recommends add \$1500. Discussion about cashflow and we

are solid given more has come in than we've spent. Motion made to increase \$1500, seconded and approved unanimously.

- Tie in to the Auction (*back to the future* theme). Ms. Perkins will provide some goals – modernize the library selections / ozobots / 3d printers

Treasurer Report

- Updated headsets for 1st grade
- DASH robots – approved and going to be paid for to allow whole class to participate (driving school activity – draw the maze for robot to follow/code). They have 8, they are getting another pack (12)
- Jan is slow month for spend and revenue. Dec spend was on Hospitality Committee events/teacher and staff support
- Anticipate more auction coming up and handling special asks – solid / positive cash balance
- “Love Your Library” event – Ms. Perkins plan to start late January and go thru February 2023
- Reports are ready to submit for Audit

Committee Reports

- Sustainability – successful event with Styrafoam recycling. Tamy and Emily – big thank yous for making it happen! 33 bags worth – moving towards the bench goal (we're at about 150lbs and target is 500lbs). Ageist in Tigard – 24/7.
- Carolyn Glen / Clothing Closet
 - The need is for teenager clothes and need volunteer help (COPPTA goes on set day a month). Ask is to gauge interest of COPPTA members to support. Shannon will get more detail and bring back.

Auction – April 21, 2023

- Matt DeWolf is working on sponsorship – handed out worksheet. Contact Matt with ideas on possible sponsors. We're at \$3K and goal was \$4K. May bump up to \$6K to cover \$2K estimate for AV needs to make sure stage is lighted for event.

 - Secured Gold Sponsor (Yvette / Oral Surgeons) at PTA meeting (THANK YOU!!)
- Committee needs help – 10 people.
- Next Meeting is 1/18 (Wed) 530 to 630
- Working on a video for the auction (Ms. Perkins to be a feature for passion for library)
- Bolton PTA is willing to help out on the day
- Deadline for invitations to go out – discuss is get out info ASAP
 - tickets are \$100/pair; \$60/single.
 - Going to go in Connections, PTA newsletter, FB pages
 - Auction procurement – in process, underway and committee welcomes help
 - Experiences of all kinds are really popular based on last year
 - Art project, water balloon – buy in per kid/person and all in packages

- Classroom Art Projects will be designed for in person (Meg will put out call to teachers for projects)
- Items we have so far: Timbers tickets, River cruise. Planning for wine wall and movie/wine night.
- Suggestions – wine tasting (if you are a member, ask for a tasting).

NEW BUSINESS

- **Enrichment Programs** – back for winter; run thru school not PTA but PTA supports. Meg report out: District determined that enrichment would start in Winter. Winter classes start last week in January and go thru 2nd week of March
 - **First round 6 weeks long.** Catalog is being finalized (about 6 classes, 10 to 20 in each). Information will go out as a standalone. Lots of offerings for various grades. There are limited spots - first come first serve is generally how it is run.
 - **Spring round of enrichment** - if parents are interested in offering up services or skills. Interested people should reach out to CPPS office for more information – google form available.
 - **Scholarships are available** – different pricing based on supplies/activities
- **Field Trips:** it is teacher driven. From Meg, PTA can support with volunteers as / if needed but they are a thing again. Meg suggests direct follow up with teachers to gauge interest, ways to help.
- **Update from last month's meeting** – we now have 2 OWL boxes from the district installed at CPPS. YES!!!!
