6:10pm Executive Board Report Thank you everyone for coming tonight, I know it's a busy month and always appreciate you showing up.

- Last month we had an OMSI family night. It was a wonderful night out with the Cedaroak/Bolton communities and we have received lots of positive feedback from the kids and parents. All the students were very responsible at the event!
- We have a bunch of fun items happening going into February and March that we
 will cover during the committee reports. We are always looking for more
 volunteers to help with these events whether it's helping with the planning
 process or day of volunteering let us know if you have an interest.

Since Covid our garden hasn't been very successful. Garden budget over the past school years has been: 2018-19 5k, 2019-20 13-15k, 2020-21 around 15k. Conclusion is our school garden is not sustainable, easily accessible for teachers and students. A team of teachers and classified staff has drafted a plan to move the garden to the available space near the swings. There is space for an enclosed garden which will be accessible to all students due to being on a cement pad. The plan will include standing planter pads, irrigation, etc. If you have comments or feedback, please contact Meg directly. There will be a fence around the garden space, so that any time of day a classroom and teacher scould have access to it.

Our school equity leadership team would like to create an event to celebrate the diversity of our community in lieu of the Earth Art Fair.

We are adding a bus to our bus routes. The routes will be posted Friday morning February 9th. The new routes will begin Monday, February 12th.

K-5 Literacy Adoption update: nine review sessions have occurred so far. The group has remained full and strong. We have collected input using forms to get feedback from those not on the team based on content of each session. Our purpose is to identify and select core and complementary/supplementary materials while being those leaders and communicators about the process and finding to keep all others at our school involved. The Adoption Team started with a blank slate. The three phases of the adoption process are to review research and data, identify and evaluate curriculum and interview publishers. We analyzed and added to the priorities list for curriculum materials based on current reading data. At the first session on September 13, we started with the questions: What are you most looking for in reading/literacy materials? What do you want to know more about to be able to select the best reading/literacy materials? The criteria of priorities are aligned with ODE and were approved. We used the rubrics to rank the five programs and narrowed our selection to three programs: 1. Benchmark Advance 2. HMH Into Reading 3. myView Literacy. There are two criteria areas that our Adoption Team returned to frequently in looking at materials and in our discussions: 1. Foundational skills, including vocabulary and connected to writing 2. Cultural responsiveness, high quality texts representing diverse cultural language backgrounds and experiences. 
6:24pm Treasurer's Report

Our parent contractor doing the install said he had no intention of billing the PTA.We could paint new lines for the court which would be a third of the cost of what we budget for the install cost. Student feedback was given that a four square designated space would be cool as well as another sensory path on the other side of the school (inclusive of hopscotch). Any interest in painting new lines on the court and a ribbon cutting / community basketball tournament? Estimated cost for painting the basketball lines and four square is quoted around \$1k, which can be used from the budget for basketball hoop installation cost which we did not incur.

Weeding takes place every month but haven't had a lot of volunteer support. Without help weeding, the school district will need to use spray that is approved to be safe around children and animals. IPM spray notices will go out when the district needs to spray. There are only around five schools in our district that are spray free. By the March PTA meeting we will need to vote on Spray or No Spray to prepare for the school district's timeline to reseed the fields in the spring.
